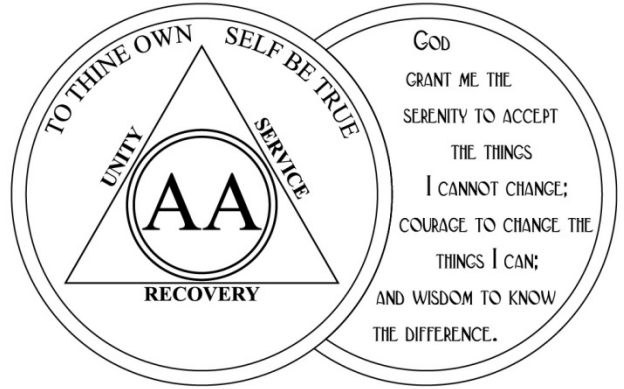

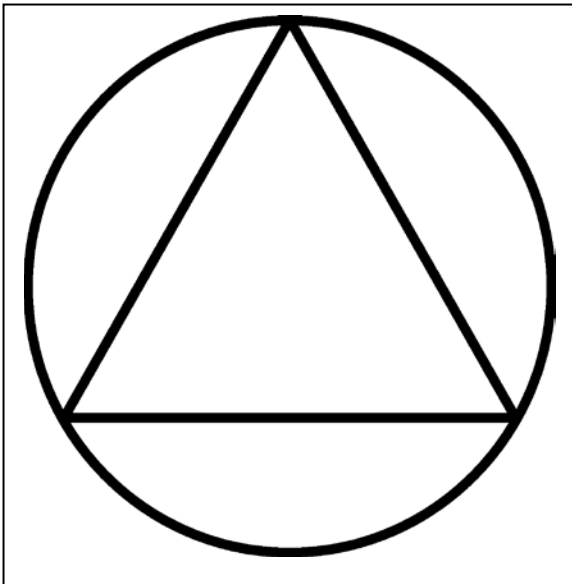

3. GSO runs short of funds some year, wouldn't it be okay to let the government subsidize AA groups in hospitals and prisons?

Concept 7: The Charter and Bylaws of the General Service Board are legal instruments, empowering the trustees to manage and conduct world service affairs. The Conference Charter is not a legal document; it relies upon tradition and the A.A. purse for final effectiveness.

1. Do we act responsibly regarding the "power of the purse?"
2. Do we realize that the practical and spiritual power of the Conference will nearly always be superior to the legal power of the G.S.B.?
