

Step 3: Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God *as we understood him*.

Tradition 3: The only requirement or AA membership is the desire to stop drinking.

- 1. In my mind, do I prejudge some new AA members as losers?
- 2. Is there some kind of alcoholic whom I privately do not want in my AA group?
- 3. Do I set myself up as a judge of whether a newcomer is sincere or phony?
- 4. Do I let language, religion (or lack of it), race, education, age, or other such things interfere with my carrying the message?
- 5. Am I overimpressed by a celebrity? By a doctor, a clergyman, an ex-convict? Or can I just treat this new member simply and naturally as one more sick human, like the rest of us?

Concept 3: To insure effective leadership, we should endow each element of A.A. —the Conference, the General Service Board and its service corporations, staffs, committees, and executives—with a traditional "Right of Decision."

- 1. Do we understand what is meant by the "Right of Decision"? Do we grant it at all levels of service or do we "instruct"?
- 2. Do we trust our trusted servants G.S.R., D.C.M., area delegate, the Conference itself??
