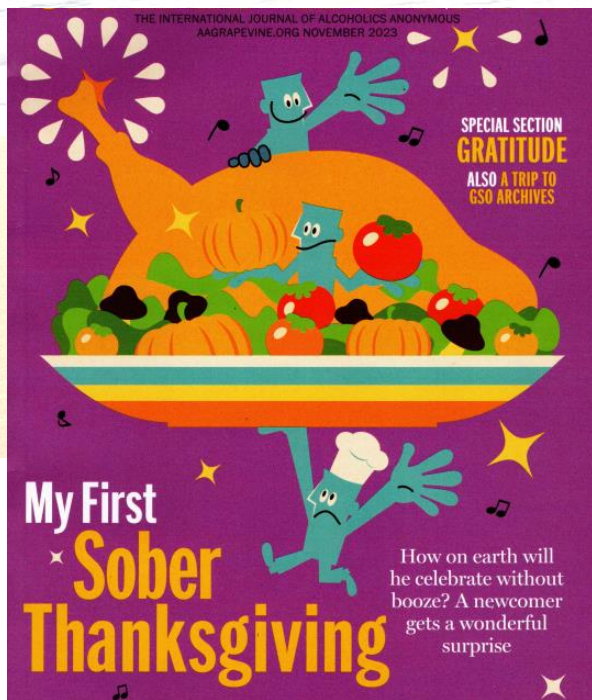

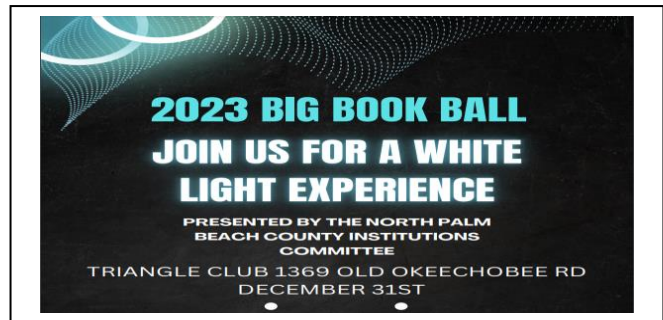
Standing Meetings


